Primer on Love

t's that time of year when big business reminds us of the "need" to fill their coffers in order to prove we're loving/ loveable... so let's do an issue on Love.

Because the word "love" means different things to different people, THE WAY of Intelligence uses a specific, old vocabulary of four words to define

love. Each of these "categories" of love has many levels.

PHILO is used for the feeling of liking things, things to your taste, things of beauty, anything. It can be on any level from the pure sensation ("I love chocolate") to affability, to say, suicide, because "I 'love' non-disturbance more than life itself."

PIA is the feeling of nurturing. Hormones jump-start it for new mothers, no doubt to help the newborn survive. It can range from "warm fuzzies" over a picture of a kitten to the certainty that you would give your life for your child, or further, for any other.

EROS is the attraction between the sexes. Most adults are aware of the various levels, from base to ecstatic.

The variations of the above are what usually passes for "love" in human society. However, philo, pia and eros are common to all mammals (and some birds) and are nothing, really, exceptional. They can be raised to a new dimension when completed by the fourth "type" of love, which THE WAY of Intelligence calls AGAPE.

The definition is this: Agape is the understanding that whatever I or another did, does, or will do, is thought at the time of doing to be right or proper or justifi-

> Agape, too, has levels. The lowest is the mental acceptance, after observing self and others, that this is the case, and therefore if I felt right or proper or justified, then everyone else does, too. It doesn't make anyone right, necessarily, but it shows that no one can act without feeling right at the time of the action.

This is the lowest level because it is mental--one must put the feeling with it to experience real love. The feeling comes with the action (the physiology of it, not just an idea), and that could be called compassion. When first three are completed with the fourth, one knows love-one doesn't "love" as a choice, one simply lives in love. That's the way it is (and THE WAY It Is).

ollowing is a transcript of a Rhondell talk Rhondell on eros; then various ancient and modern passages that may sound quite different if understood from the Intelligent point of view.

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Sexuality

From a talk given by Rhondell

There was a request for a given subject to be discussed. Being rather incompetent to discuss it, I will be like the doctor I was told about when I was going to school. Said he was a "fit" specialist. He was just perfect, he could handle anybody that had fits. One day, a man came in with pneumonia. He said, "Well, I really don't know a thing in the world about pneumonia, but if we can just drive it into fits, I'm just hell on fits." This is the way of sex, if I can turn it into integration, I'm hell on integration. Let's see if we can do it, okay?

Sex is the great symbol, for one thing. It is the urge to union. Without it no one would possibly ever be interested in put ting themselves together, because there is this constant urge to union, which of course is the symbol of the union of the human being. That is sometimes referred to as the sexual urge. Freud referred to it as the libido, which is the constant urge for union.

If the person joins the union in man and woman, male and female, there is a great possibility of a new life coming. Where there is a union of X and awareness and one is together again, there is a new man, a new being. The new man would never occur if it were not for this urge known as sex.

Like every other thing that man has available, he generally messes it up by turning it upside down. One of the things that comes from the union of the person, when he is Oneness, is joy, beyond all comprehension. Sex, of course, brings about certain pleasurable sensations, which is a symbol again of the joy of being one within ourselves instead of being fragmented into separate aspects.

In the urge to union, man finds the sensation and, being a servant of the senses rather than allowing the senses to be a reporter, he becomes a slave in trying to have the sensation in ever increasing degree. Consequently, having an ideal set up that the sensation should be some great something that it seldom is, most people feel that they are somewhat disappointed in sex, they expected more of it than it was designed as its great symbol to perform, and it was not the sensation they expected so they look for something to blame.

When a person is disappointed the first thing they do is feel hurt, put-upon or mistreated in one form or another, then of course they look for blame and when they find themselves to blame, they feel loaded sown with guilt, or they find somebody else to be the blame and come up with fear. So anger, fear or guilt are the common states a person has when they recognize sex only as a way to have sensations. They are a slave to the sensations. They are angry or they feel guilty or they are fearful concerning sex. That turns it into everything except the symbol.

When any action is misunderstood (when any function of the human being is misunderstood), there comes about stressful states. If it is understood, that it is a symbol of union-it is much like, possibly, a sacrament known as "Bread and Wine", which is to be done as a reminder. If sex were a reminder, that this is the urge to union, the union that really counts, is the union within. The person is ONE, WHOLE. Of course, two people in an act of embrace can be one, for a little while. That is not its only purpose. It is the purpose of supplying the urge towards this inner union in which a new man comes about. This is the new man, this can be the symbol of it and, of course, there is the possibility of a new life there.

Sex is a great symbol of integration and when performed can be considered to be such. One uses it as a reminder, then sex is a sacrament. If it is misused, it is an urge to have some sensation, hoping to find the ideal, then it becomes a form of insanity, and leads to every form of stressful situation.

Sex is a very natural state of affairs. I tell people I grew up on a farm. We had hundreds of animals on the farm. My father owned a considerable sized farm and he had a lot of saddle horses, a whole bunch of cattle, a whole bunch of sheep and hogs and dogs and cats and all these. I never saw a one of them have a sex problem. But human beings are continually making it important. These things out there, they didn't make it important, they just used it for what it was, an urge to union and a new creature came into being from it. That was all there was to it. They didn't get any guilt feelings over it, they didn't have any embarrassment over it, they didn't have any fear over it and they certainly didn't have any anger over it unless someone else started cutting in on the act. Once in a while, one bull knocked another one down but they soon found who was the biggest and that ended that show. There was no problem concerned with it. Growing up in that place, I ever saw that there was much of a problem with it.

Of course as I began to study things in a different world, it was fairly easy to see what it all amounted to. It is this urge to union. When so recognized and so seen, it is a sacrament. When it is not seen as such, it is perversion of a sacrament and that is called blasphemy, I believe, is that right? There's another word for it too, not just blasphemy at any rate, it is desecration, that's the word. It becomes an act of desecration when it is used only for the idea of gain sensation and escape pain.

In the modern world, obviously, this gets to be very commonly known, it is used with the attempt to prevent any possibility of a new life coming into being. Every urge has prevented it. Obviously, this is re-

flected in the inner state of every being, the they are also using every device possible prevent the new man from coming into b ing, because they want to prevent that unic from forming any returns. When one inte feres with it on one level, one is pretty apt be interfering with it on another level. Whe one deliberately interferes with the repri ductive function, to prevent it from repre ducing a new life, one is obviously on interested in the fact that it might produc pleasant sensations. Such, of course, woul result in all manner of frustration because will never produce the ideal sensation or wants, or if it does, one wants more. Then w can begin to sell aphrodisiacs. There is great demand for those. Most people don know that, but I used to have, when worked as a general practitioner, an averas of fifteen requests per week for aphrodisiac You know what an aphrodisiac is? That something that will stimulate the sexuurge so that we could gain more and more pleasure. So the whole idea is that sex is for pleasurable sensations only and if it doesn produce the ideal one, there is some tremer dous problem that should be straightene out, is rather erroneous.

When one sees it for what it is, one recog nizes the beauty of a sacrament and it is s practiced as such, not as a perversion as means to try to gain ever-increasing stimu of pleasant sensation. As long as it does the you will have nothing but problems over call them what you will. As long as one see it as a sacrament and it is practiced as suc there is untold joy. It is a definite aid then, to wards the person going toward total on ness within oneself. As long as it is used as struggle towards an ideal, pleasant senstions, it is a disintegrating factor like an thing else.

Chapter Eight from Life's Word (Anonymous)

The Eighth Mystery is the Mystery of Regeneration.

Thou canst not obtain this mystery by striving, nor by study, nor by belief. It shall be a growth of the character of thy body.

Unless thou hast suffered the seven first mysteries in thy body, and hast left thy body free to be controlled by Me, thou canst not feel in thy body this Eighth Mystery.

When it is inspired by love it will strive only for the pleasure of thy mate and no longer for its own pleasure. Then the sacred distillation of thy strength will not spend, but will be redistilled unto the renewing of youth.

Thou wilt not suddenly enter the life of Regeneration. Thy body will not change completely when the first inspiration of unselfish love comes unto thee. Many times shall the old feeling of desire come back to thee, but ever will I inspire thee more and more with the sweet patience of My pure love, and thou wilt more and more realize the life that I am living withir thee.

Dost thou say, "The mate which I have taken is not now my ideal"? Yet shalt thou see that thy mate is the best one for thee, and that I have Myself provided such a mate for thee that I might teach thee unselfish love. For I will inspire thy heart with love that will ask for no return, no faithfulness, no kindness, no support. And I will give thee such joy in that love that thy body will be glorified and rejuvenated.

As long as thy heart is not ready for the inspiration of My love, thou wilt seek to obtain love from others, and will be dissatisfied with what thou dost obtain, for thou canst only live in the love radiated from within thine own body. But when the fullness of My life shall come unto thee, thou shalt rejoice in the mate thou hast and shall love that one with a gladness that shall triumph over every fault. For a selfish mate gives thee the opportunity to be unselfish. Also a cross mate gives thee the opportunity to be sweet-tempered.

Yet have patience and know that if thou art now yet a radiant center of love and unselfishness and sweet temper, still thou shalt become such. And to that end do I send thee trials that thou mayest learr to exercise those qualities which others seem to thee to lack.

So it is well for thee to cling to the ancient sacrament of marriage in thy days of desire and in thy days of inspiration, for it shall be unto thee a trial and yet a joy, and out of it will grow thy real strength.

Yet I do not command thee to heed these words, for My message is only what thou canst receive, and if thou dost not believe these words to be My message, yet ther shall thy disbelief have some effect upor tee, and whatever the effect upon thee may be, THAT is My message to thee.♥

Awareness & Union

Some modern women might detect a subtle sexism in some of THE WAY of Intelligence material regarding eros, and I tend to agree--if one takes it literally, not symbolically, as it is intended. The "feminine" Awareness is the receptive, the submissive, the vessel to be cleansed to be filled (and beloved) while "masculine" X is the initiator, penetrator, assertive "filler" of the vessel (and lover).

Some years ago I wrote about this in *Sophia, Wise Woman's Journal,* and I thought a rerun might be appropriate for this issue's theme.

And the house was filled with the odour of the ointment. ... And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with her tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head. Thou gavest me kno kiss;: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet. My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my feet with ointment. Of the forms I admire are containers, especially beautiful bowls or jars on pedestals or other stands. I see them as repre-

senting a Soul carried by the physical body or lampstand; the bowl is the Soul, the lamp, and the contents, of course, is the Light. I think of this form as "Mary's Jar," full of something precious (the precious contents of her jar symbolizing Spirit) which, by giving back to Spirit, represents Spirit loving Spirit, or, simply, Love. Real Love permeates everything (as the odor permeated the Pharisee's house) and there is no telling where the object of love and lover begin or end because they merge. Especially I like that she anointed him, rubbed precious ointment into his flesh... what an earthy image, a holy act of love between "masculine" and "feminine," where they become one, are no longer separate, but in union have created something new.


She is down on the floor (the foundation), at his feet (his purpose). Yes, she is "subservient" to Spirit, as are we, Awareness is. Spirit existed before our having entered this realm. Spirit incarnated into the unique expression here that is you, that is I. We are something new, and need to "create ourselves" in order that Spirit experience all we can do.

But "subservient" loses its meaning when the process is seen, when all works together. Ibn al `Arabi puts it perfectly: "Where then is His self-sufficiency since I help Him and grant Him bliss?" We are needed.

The lamp and the lampstand work together in this earthy realm, to support and direct the Light. That is the "duty" of each of us. But duty becomes privilege when imbued with Love.

The story of Mary at the foot of her Lord represents the union of Spirit and Awareness, "and the odour filled the house." A purified Awareness will radiate the light throughout your house--and beyond. ♥







THE WAY of Intelligence THE PICTURE OF MAN






A human being has four aspects, which are not separate but are interdependent. The first is the biological aspect of LIFE FORCE, called X here because it is not really definable—one knows it's there, one knows when it isn't, in any creature. So, as in algebra, an X is used to denote that something is there which cannot yet be precisely defined. Next is the AWARENESS FUNCTION, which is the senses but more than the senses when developed. A developed Awareness Function is more than the "programming" of the brain, it determines feelings. The third aspect is the MOTOR FUNCTION, the PHYSICAL BODY through which life is lived. The fourth aspect is the ACTIVITY of the whole. When a single-minded purpose is the foundation of a person's life, there is no conflict and he or she functions with all aspects in harmony. The person is at ease.. The Awareness Function receives impressions from within and without, from other people, places, things, events. It forms a feeling about those impressions which it does not choose to ignore, and the feeling is in tune with the purpose of living. The feeling of Awareness is a medium of communication with the Life Force, X, which responds appropriately through the Physical Body to the information received, and Action ensues.

The Way of the World

THE PICTURE OF MAN with purpose of living to be non-disturbed



Few people function as the human being was designed as in the previous diagram. Wher infant is born, the trauma of leaving the non-disturbed uterine world is reacted to wit feeling that the whole purpose of living is to regain the non-disturbed state. That decis becomes the attitude and action from then on. As he grows, the child makes more decision to how to gain his purpose of non-disturbance. He complains, which works for an infa When one day this fails to work, he sticks up for his "rights", or demands non-disturbat (These begin the A-side of the Picture of Man.) Eventually he finds that pleasing pec sometimes gets him his way. (This begins the B-side.) At this point conflict sets in. He want cry "but" feels he "should" please. Then he sees parents, teachers, others as authorities. The understandable for a child and helps keep him safe. It is not adult behavior, however. continual conflict between what he wants to do and what he "should" do (conflict between side and B-side) intensifies and he feels if he would improve, things would be better. I doesn't work, either, and he blames everyone and everything for his disturbances, living conflict, except when distracted. Conflict is felt by the Awareness Function to be emergency. This false emergency is communicated to the Life Force, X, which always does appropriate thing FOR THE INFORMATION RECEIVED, in this case supplying energy to figh run. If this mobilized energy is not used in violent activity, it disintegrates the body; us emergency energy in a non-emergency is unusual behavior; neither is harmonious livi Eventually disintegration ensues.

The Four Dual Basic Urges are not "right/wrong" or "good/bad" or "should/shouldn't". They are simply byproducts or side-effects of living, not the whole purpose of living. Because all humans are subject to all the Four Dual Basic Urges, when they are made the whole purpose of living (unconsciously, beginning during the uncomfortable birth process) they have to result in conflict-one wants all the "gain" side and none of the "escape" side, and this is not possible on planet Earth. THE WAY of Intelligence is not to self-improve by rejecting them; The Way is to observe self and one's reactions to them, checking to see if they are the purpose of living--or not. They will come up and can be ignored if one chooses.

THE WAY OF JUSTICE "An eye for an eye"--not your life for an eye.

THE WAY OF UNDERSTANDING

Understanding that whatever any person including myself has done, is doing, will do, is felt at the time of doing to be right or proper or justified with the light he has at the moment.

THE WAY OF INTELLIGENCE

Aware of the Purpose of Living, the will to do it-knowing what I am, where one am, what's going on, and what Ican do. In charge of myinner state.
